## **GUEST Pre-Hire Checklist:**

#### General:

- Pots, pans, and cutlery can make noise during travel, so pack items around them to secure them.
- Remove the grill pan from the oven and store it elsewhere or wrap it in a tea towel to prevent noise and damage.
- ✓ Park on as level ground as possible to ensure stability and comfort during your stay.
- Before each journey, check oil and water levels, especially for long-distance driving. Refer to the re-cap for oil type.

#### General Road Behavior:

- Familiarize yourself with UK road signs and regulations, and always abide by the highway code.
- Use passing places to allow traffic behind you to pass, especially in Scotland & Cornwall.
- Respect speed limits and drive accordingly, including on motorways and built-up areas.
- ✓ Use direction indicators when appropriate to signal your intentions to other drivers.

### Parking:

- Check for height barriers and signs prohibiting motorhomes at parking areas.
- Read and follow parking rules and regulations signposted in the area.
- Mensure clear visibility of your parking ticket in the windscreen and pay for the appropriate allocated time.
- Use larger spacing for larger vehicles, avoiding occupying more than one space.
- Use park and ride facilities in highly populated tourist areas where roads may be unsuitable for motorhomes.

## Reversing:

- Have someone outside to guide you while reversing.
- Exercise caution and patience while maneuvering, especially in tight spaces.

### Campsite:

- Tidy your pitch before leaving and dispose of any rubbish properly.
- Check out and pay site fees at reception before departure.
- Use a flag as a marker if leaving your pitch for a day out, for easy identification upon return.

### Fire Precautions:

- Familiarize yourself with onboard safety measures.
- Know campsite fire meeting points and alarms.

## Wild Camping:

- Avoid wild camping where signs prohibit it.
- Check leisure battery regularly, especially when camping off-grid, and conserve power as needed.
- Use eco-friendly practices and dispose of waste responsibly.

#### Pets:

- Adhere to pet policies and keep pets under control at all times.
- Clean up after your pet and dispose of waste properly.
