HOW TO CLEAN YOUR MOTORHOME IN 30 MINUTES



EMPTY THE INTERIOR: START BY CHECKING THE INTERIOR OF THE MOTORHOME. EMPTY THE BINS AND CHECK THE WATER AND WASTEWATER TANK. DON'T FORGET TO EMPTY THE TOILET CASSETTE.

WINDOWS: USE MICROFIBRE CLOTHS OR SOFT BRUSHES TO CLEAN ACRYLIC WINDOWS TO PREVENT SCRATCHING. FOLLOW WITH YOUR PREFERRED WINDOW DETERGENT OR A MIXTURE OF VINEGAR AND WATER. WIPE THE SIDE MIRRORS FOR CLEAR VISIBILITY.

CLEAN APPLIANCES: THOROUGHLY CLEAN APPLIANCES SUCH AS THE MICROWAVE, FRIDGE, COOKER, SINK, AND TOILET. ENSURE EVERYTHING IS LEFT SPARKLING CLEAN.

WIPE ALL SURFACES: USE A MICROFIBRE CLOTH TO WIPE DOWN ALL SURFACES, INCLUDING BLINDS AND FOLD-OUT TABLES, WITH SOAPY WATER TO COLLECT DUST AND DIRT.

HOOVER: REMOVE YOUR SHOES BEFORE VACUUMING TO AVOID SPREADING DIRT. FROM THIS POINT ON, KEEP THE MOTORHOME A NO-SHOES ZONE.

RETURN EVERYTHING BACK: PACK AWAY THE KITCHEN ESSENTIALS AND ANY OTHER ITEMS YOU REMOVED BEFORE CLEANING, ENSURING EVERYTHING IS RETURNED TO ITS PLACE.

FINAL TOUCHES: PERFORM A FINAL CHECK TO ENSURE THE MOTORHOME IS READY TO RETURN TO THE RENTAL DEPOT.
